We are very grateful for your generous offer to provide charity treatment to Makara Tuan, a 14 year old Cambodian girl. We treated this young girl in our free outpatient mobile medical clinic in late November 2007 near her village of Svay Rolom, Cambodia. Our group, Operation Renewed Hope, is an international medical relief organization providing medical clinics, dental clinics, optometric clinics, medical equipment donations, and Christian spiritual hope to patients. We have been operating since 1992 providing medical services free of charge to Panama, Mexico, Thailand, Uganda, Guyana, Cambodia, Indonesia, Honduras, and the United States.

I have volunteered my services since the inception of Operation Renewed Hope and have attended every international medical clinic. When we encountered Makara Tuan, it was obvious that she had suffered from a pathologic fracture related to a bone tumor or cyst. We obtained radiographs and carried them to the United States with the vision of obtaining medical care for this young girl residing in a country with limited medical resources incapable of treating her complicated condition. I consulted with colleagues in Cincinnati, OH who determined that this young girl had an Aneurysmal Bone Cyst. She needs some complicated surgical procedures and extensive rehabilitation. Dr. Andrew Cappuccino has graciously offered to provide charity care and management of her case and has obtained charity anesthesiology care and now hospital and rehabilitation services through Kenmore Mercy Hospital.

We are in the process of obtaining a visa for this young girl. We do not know the exact date of her arrival to the United States but anticipate it to be in February or March of 2008 pending visa approval. We anticipate that Deborah Franco who has volunteered her residence and family as the host family will be given temporary legal guardian ship and power of attorney including medical power of attorney
